Gonzalo Gamio of Sony and Rubén Álvarez of Shure will provide insights on how the integration of AI in audiovisual production and microphone selection can elevate the quality of the content created.

The digital transformation in the data center sector is an issue that cannot be overlooked. Data centers are the heart of modern digital infrastructure, providing the resources needed for a wide range of digital services. Amet Novillo, president of MEXDC, will discuss the opportunities and prospects for system integrators in this area. Investment in data centers not only generates direct and indirect jobs, but also stimulates demand for digital and related services, including energy and construction, and attracts capital from related industries.
